AN ACT to Provide For An Audit of the Books and Accounts
of Institutions Receiving Assistance from the State.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter two, of the revised statutes, is hereby amended by adding after section one hundred and five the following section:

'Sec. 105A. The state auditor shall annually audit the books and accounts of all institutions receiving a grant of money from the legislature, or he may accept reports of audits made by competent accountants of the books and accounts of such institutions.'
