STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Amount Raised by Towns for School
Purposes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Certain towns to raise only \$1000 for school purposes. Towns having an assessed valuation of under two hundred thousand dollars shall be required to raise only one thousand dollars for school purposes. Such further amount as may be necessary to maintain the public schools shall be paid by the state.
