STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to the Taxation of Real Estate of Railroad
Corporations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

That section four of chapter thirteen of the Revised Statutes be amended by adding after the word "way" in the second line thereof, 'and so much of its land within its located right of way as is used for any purpose other than the operation of its railroad,' so that said section four, as amended, shall read as follows :

'Sec. 4. The buildings of every railroad corporation or association, whether within or without the located right of way, and so much of its land within its located right of way as is used for any purpose other than the operation of its railroad, and its lands and fixtures outside of its located right of way are subject to taxation by cities and towns in which the same are situated, as other property is taxed therein and shall be regarded as non-resident land.'
