STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to the Enforcement of the Law Regulating
the Sale of Narcotics.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter 23 of the Revised Statutes of 1930 is hereby amended by inserting between sections 32 and 33, the following section:

'Sec. 2. The Commissioner of Agriculture shall diligently enforce all provisions of this chapter in collaboration with the Commissioners of Pharmacy, and shall be entitled to and shall receive the assistance of the Attorney General and of the several county attorneys.'
