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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

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AN ACT Amending the Statute of Limitations in Certain  
Actions.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section ninety-two of chapter ninety-five of the revised statutes of nineteen hundred and thirty is hereby amended by inserting in the second line thereof after the word "libel," the words, 'and malpractice of physicians and all others engaged in the healing art' so that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sec. 92. Actions for assault and battery and for false imprisonment, slander and libel, and malpractice of physicians and all others engaged in the healing art, shall be commenced within two years after the cause of action accrues.'
