AN ACT Relating to Employees on Third Class Highways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Employees on third class highways to be insured. All persons employed on third class highway projects within the state shall come under the provisions and receive the benefits of the Workmen's Compensation Act as employees of the state.

Sec. 2. Repealing clause. Any sections of the revised statutes that are in conflict with the provisions of section one are hereby amended or repealed in order to conform with this act.
