STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to the Definition of the word "Chauffeur."

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section thirty-six of chapter twenty-nine of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding after the word "therewith" in the twenty-fifth line, the following: 'provided, however, it shall not include any person whose duties include only the occasional operation of a motor vehicle.' So that the sixth paragraph of said section shall read as follows:

'The word "chauffeur" as herein used shall mean any person who operates a motor vehicle other than his own, and who, directly or indirectly, receives compensation, for any work or services in connection therewith; provided, however, it shall not include any person whose duties include only the occasional operation of a motor vehicle; but as used elsewhere generally in this chapter with respect to the use and operation of motor vehicles the word "operator" and "driver" shall include the word "chauffeur."
