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AN ACT Relating to Penalty for Refusal to Report to State  
Auditor.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Penalty for violation of section 103 of chapter 5. Section one hundred three of chapter five of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end of said section the following words: 'Any failure or refusal by a town or city officer to furnish such information shall be punished by a fine of fifty dollars and costs,' so that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sec. 103. State auditor to investigate systems of municipal accounting; penalty. The state auditor shall inquire into the systems of accounting of public funds in all cities, towns, and village corporations and it shall be the duty of all municipal officers to furnish information relative thereto on such forms as he may prescribe. Any failure or refusal by a town or city officer to furnish such information shall be punished by a fine of fifty dollars and costs.'
