AN ACT Relating to Returns Made by Lobster Fishermen.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Lobster fishermen to make quarterly returns. All lobster fishermen shall make a quarterly return on January one, April one, July one and October one, of each year, to the director of sea and shore fisheries of his itemized receipts and expenditures for the preceding three months on blanks to be furnished by the said director.

Sec. 2. Repealing clause. All acts and rules and regulations inconsistent with the preceding section are hereby repealed.
