STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to the Number of Ballots to be Provided at Elections.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S. c. 8, sec. 4. Relating to number of ballots to be provided at elections. Section four of chapter eight of the revised statutes is hereby amended by striking out all of said section and inserting in lieu thereof the following, so that said section, as amended, shall read as follows:

'Sec. 4. Number of ballots to be provided. There shall be provided for each voting place, at which an election is to be held, one set of such general ballots and one set of ballots containing any constitutional amendment or other question submitted to the vote of the people, each of not less than seventy-five for each fifty or fraction of fifty votes cast in said voting place at the next preceding election, city, state, or national, corresponding to and in congruity with the election for which said ballots are to be provided.'
