STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

RESOLVE, providing for the payment of certain amounts due exhibitors at the Central Maine Fair Association in nineteen hundred and twenty-nine, on account of State Stipend.

RESOLVED: that there be paid to Victor Grange and one-hundred forty-eight other exhibitors at the Central Maine Fair Association in nineteen hundred and twenty-nine the sum of nine hundred and twenty nine dollars and eighty eight cents being the amount the State of Maine would have paid said association had said association complied with all provisions of chapter thirty-nine, section twenty-five. R. S.

Said sum to be distributed among such exhibitors by the commissioner of agriculture in accordance with the amounts awarded them in premiums upon live-stock, agricultural and domestic products but not paid by said society.
