STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT to Regulate Fishing in Sandy River and its
Tributaries, Franklin County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to fish for, take, catch or kill in any one day more than fifteen fish in Sandy River or any of its tributaries, situated in Franklin County.

Sec. 2. It shall be unlawful for any person to fish for, take, catch or kill any fish from the above-named waters less than seven inches in length.
