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STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

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AN ACT pertaining to drains and common sewers.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sections 8, 9, 10, and 11 of Chapter 25 of the Revised Statutes of 1930, are hereby repealed, and Section 12 is hereby amended by striking out the words "seven preceding sections" and substituting therefore the words, 'Sections five, six and seven' so that this section shall read as follows:

'Sec. 12. Application of. Sections five, six and seven shall not apply to any city or town, until they shall have been accepted by the inhabitants of such town or the city council of such city at a meeting legally called therefore.'
