STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Trial Terms in York County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Trial terms in York county. Section twenty-one of chapter ninety-one of the revised statutes is hereby amended by striking out the last paragraph of said section and inserting in place thereof the following paragraph:

'York: At Alfred on the second Tuesday of January and first Tuesdays of May and October.'

Section five of chapter ninety-two of the revised statutes is hereby amended by striking out the last two lines of the last paragraph of said section and substituting in place thereof the following words: 'and regular sessions shall be held on the first Tuesday of each month at Alfred.', so that said last paragraph shall read as follows:

'York, terms of record on the first Tuesday of April and October at Alfred, and regular sessions shall be held on the first Tuesday of each month at Alfred.'
