## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT to Legalize Meetings Held by the Sea and Shore Fisheries Commission Since the Expiration of the Terms, for which They were Appointed, of One or More of Them, and to Make Valid any Findings that They may Render as a Result of Same.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

That all meetings which have been held by the Sea and Shore Fisheries Commission, when all three members of the Commission and its director have been present, are hereby made legal, even though the term of one or more of them shall have expired, and any decisions that they may render as a result of such meetings shall be valid.
