STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT to Provide a Better Government for the Town of Bar Harbor.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., c. 10, sec. 12; relating to a Better Government for the Town of Bar Harbor, amended. Private and special laws nineteen hundred and twenty-seven, chapter ten, section twelve, is hereby amended by striking out the words "not to exceed four thousand dollars per year" in the second line thereof and inserting the words 'not to exceed six thousand dollars per year' in the place thereof, so that said section as amended, shall read as follows:

'Sec. 12. Town manager to devote entire time to office; salary and expenses. The town manager shall devote his entire time to his said office, and shall receive for his services a sum not to exceed six thousand dollars per year, and actual and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of his duties, to be paid by the town treasurer in monthly payments on the first day of every month.'
