STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to the Bangor Theological Seminary.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. All provisions of law limiting the amount of property which may be taken and held, or the amount of income which may be received by the Bangor Theological Seminary, a corporation now located at said Bangor in the County of Penobscot and State of Maine, are repealed, and that corporation may take and hold property and receive income, for the purposes for which it was incorporated, to any amount.

Sec. 2. All provisions of law prohibiting anyone, who is not a native born citizen, from ever being a trustee or holding any office in said corporation are hereby repealed.
