RESOLVE Granting Teacher's Pension to Mrs. Susan Pope
of Westbrook.

Resolved: That a pension of \$275 per year be, and
hereby is, granted to Mrs. Susan Pope of Westbrook, to be
paid quarterly from the appropriation for Teachers' Pensions.
Said pension shall begin July 1, 1931 and continue until other-
wise provided by the legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mrs. Pope will be forty-nine years of age in March and has taught twenty-five years in the public schools of Maine. She is permanently disabled and never will be able to teach again nor earn her livelihood in any other way. Possessing the required years of service it would seem advisable that she be granted the appropriate pension for that period of service.
