STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Better Fire Protection for Municipalities.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter twelve of the revised statutes of nineteen hundred and thirty is hereby amended by adding to said chapter the following section:

'Sec. 100. All moneys collected by authority of this chapter from insurance companies for taxes on fire premiums shall, on the first day of April in each year, be equally divided among the several towns in the state, and on or before the first day of May there shall be returned to the treasurer of each town its proportional part of said moneys, to be held and used only for fire protection purposes.

It is hereby further provided that no portion of said moneys shall be paid to any town unless it maintains an organized fire department furnished with fire-fighting apparatus by said town.'
