STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Limiting Catch of Black Bass in Great and Long Ponds.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Catch of black bass limited. It shall be unlawful for any person to take, catch or kill in any one day more than four black bass of the legal length in Great and Long ponds in the Belgrade chain of lakes in Kennebec county.
