STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Authorizing the County Commissioners of Lincoln
County to Transfer Certain Real Estate.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

Section 1. The county commissioners of Lincoln county are hereby authorized and empowered to sell, assign, transfer and convey all the interest of the county of Lincoln in and to the jail property, so-called, situated on Federal street in Wiscasset, for such consideration as they may determine.

Sec. 2. The said county commissioners are hereby further authorized and empowered to sell, assign, transfer and convey any real estate owned by the county of Lincoln, and situated in the rear of and adjoining the lot on which stands the First Parish Congregational Church.

Sec. 3. The said county commissioners are hereby further authorized and empowered to sell, assign, transfer and convey to the owners of the said First Parish Church, a right of way extending over the court house lot and line contiguous to said church property.
