STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to the April Term of the Superior Court
for Penobscot County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section twenty-one of chapter ninety-one of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto under subdivision "Penobscot" the following:

'All recognizances from municipal courts and trial justices in which parties are held to await the action of the grand jury made returnable to said April term shall when no grand jury is in attendance be continued to and have day in the next term of the court held in said county,' so that said subdivision as amended shall read as follows:

'Penobscot: At Bangor on the first Tuesdays of January, April, June, September and November and the criminal business of said county shall be transacted at the terms held on the first Tuesdays of January, June and September, together with civil business and the criminal business of said county may be transacted at the April term together with civil business provided that the grand jury shall not attend at the April term unless specially summoned by order of a justice of said court. All recognizances from municipal courts and trial justices in which parties are held to await the action of the grand jury made returnable to said April term shall when no grand jury is in attendance be continued to and have day in the next term of the court held in said county.'
