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## STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

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AN ACT Amendatory of Chapter One Hundred Seventy-one of the Private and Special Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Five Entitled "An Act to Incorporate the Fort Kent Water Company."

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. P. & S. L., 1905, c. 171, sec. 11; relating to holding of property, amended. Section eleven of chapter one hundred seventy-one of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred five entitled "An Act to incorporate the Fort Kent Water Company" is hereby amended by striking out all of said section eleven and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

'Sec. 11. Said company, for all of its said purposes, may hold real and personal property necessary and convenient therefor.'

Sec. 2. P. & S. L., 1905, c. 171, sec. 12; relating to issuance of bonds, amended. Section twelve of said act is hereby amended by striking out all of said section twelve and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

'Sec. 12. Said company may, subject to the approval of the public utilities commission, issue its bonds for any purpose enumerated in chapter sixty-two of the revised statutes of nineteen hundred thirty, upon such rates, terms and time as it may deem expedient, and secure the same by mortgage of its franchise and property.'
