STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Meda C. Pea-
body, of Dixmont.

Resolved: That a pension of twenty dollars per month
month be and hereby is, granted to Meda C. Peabody, of Dix-
mont, to be paid quarterly from the funds for pensions for
soldiers and their dependents. Said pension shall begin
January first, nineteen hundred and thirty-one, and continue
until otherwise provided by the legislature.
