STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

RESOLVE, Providing for an Increase in State Pension for Annie M. Welch of Kennebunk.

Resolved: That a pension of fifteen dollars per month be, and hereby is, granted to Annie M. Welch, of Kennebunk, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July first, nineteen hundred and thirty-one, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature, and shall be in lieu of the state pension which she is now receiving.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Annie M. Welch is the daughter of a Civil War veteran. She was granted a state pension by chapter fifty-six of the resolves of nineteen hundred and twenty-one, and this was increased by chapter thirty-three of the resolves of nineteen hundred and twenty-five and chapter thirty-one of the resolves of nineteen hundred and twenty-nine. The present rate is \$12.00 per month. This amount is not sufficient, and her condition is such that she will have to have a further increase to enable her to get along without assistance from the town.
