RESOLVE, to Repeal a Resolve Providing for a State Pension for Frank A. Choate.

Resolved: That chapter seventeen of the resolves of nineteen hundred and twenty-nine, providing for a state pension for Frank A. Choate, be, and hereby is, repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Frank A. Choate was granted a state pension of 12.00 per month by Chapter 17 of the Resolves of 1929. He is now an inmate of the Bangor State Hospital. The pension is of no benefit to him, as his maintenance can be taken care of by the State under the general provisions for support of poor patients committed to hospitals for the insane.
