IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for George A.

Choate of Montville.

Resolved: That a pension of twelve dollars per month be, and hereby is, granted to George A. Choate, of Montville, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July first, nineteen hundred and thirty-one, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

George A. Choate is the son of Albert Choate, who served in Co. C, 19th Maine Infantry, during the Civil War, and died in 1913. He was in the service three and one-half years. The Post Office address of George A. Choate is Thorndike R. F., D. 2.
