STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT to provide for the further issuance of State Highway and Bridge Bonds.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. In addition to state highway and bridge bonds heretofore issued in the name and behalf of the State, and in addition to three million dollars of state highway and bridge bonds authorized to be issued by the eighty-fifth legislature under the provisions of an emergency bill, the Treasurer of State is hereby expressly authorized, in accordance with and under the provisions of Chapter one hundred thirty of the Private and Special Laws of one thousand nine hundred and twenty-nine, to issue from time to time serial coupon bonds in the name and behalf of the State to an amount not exceeding four million dollars. The Governor and Council are also hereby authorized, in accordance with and under the provisions of said Chapter one hundred thirty of the Private and Special Laws of one thousand nine hundred and twenty-nine, to issue, in their discretion, like bonds for the building of bridges, to an amount not exceeding one million dollars in any one fiscal year.

Sec. 2. All of the provisions of Sections one, two, three, four and five of said Chapter one hundred thirty of the Private and Special Laws of one thousand nine hundred twenty-nine are made applicable to this act.
