STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Pre-bid Qualifications for State Contracts.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Pre-bid qualifications. Section eleven of chapter twenty-eight of the revised statutes is hereby amended by striking out in the twelfth line of said section the words "or surety bond"; and by striking out in the fifteenth line of said section the words "or surety bonds", so that the third sentence of said section as amended shall read as follows:

Pre-bid qualifications. 'Each bidder must accompany his bid with a certified check, payable to the treasurer of state, for ten per cent of the amount of his bid as a guarantee that if the work is awarded to him he will contract with the commission for its due execution; such checks shall be returned to the respective unsuccessful bidders.'
