STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to the Construction of Culverts by the
State Highway Commission.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Materials to be used in culverts. On all roads that are built in whole or in part by the aid of money from the state, the state highway commission shall put in culverts that are made from concrete, iron or stone, only.
