STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Proposing an Amendment to the Motor Vehicle Law Requiring Hand Signals on Turning or Stopping or Signals by a Mechanical Device Approved by the Secretary of State.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter 29 of the revised statutes of 1930 is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:

'The driver of any motor propelled vehicle upon the highways prior to stopping or to any change of direction shall give a hand signal or an appropriate signal by a mechanical device approved by the secretary of state.'
