STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Registration of Motor Vehicles and Licensing of Operators of Motor Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Amend section thirty of chapter twenty-nine of the revised statutes by striking out the entire section and substituting the following:

'The secretary of state may appoint deputies or agents, stationed at convenient places in the state, and when the municipal officers of a town make application therefor, he shall appoint and deputize the tax collector of such town, to receive applications for registration and licenses, and to conduct examinations when ordered by the secretary of state, and under his directions and regulations.

Inspectors may be delegated to act as such deputies or agents. The secretary of state may appoint and deputize agents to receive applications for registration and licenses, as aforesaid, for such periods of the year as he deems necessary.'
