IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Care of Burying Grounds.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Care of burying grounds. Chapter twenty-four of the revised statutes is hereby amended by inserting a new section after section nineteen of said chapter, to be numbered nineteen A and to read as follows:

'Sec. 19A. Grass to be cut twice a year. All public cemeteries shall be cared for in the following manner by the cities and towns in which they are located: the grass, except that on private lots, shall be cut and raked once before July first and once more before September first of each year.'
