STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT in regard to the practice of any healing art or science.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section I. No person, firm, organization or corporation shall engage in the practice of any healing art or science, to be practiced on the human body, and charge a fee therefor, without having first met the requirements of one of the examining boards designated in Chapter twenty-one (21) of the Revised Statutes of 1930 and having been legally licensed by one of said boards.

Sec. 2. Any person, firm, organization or corporation practicing in violation of this act shall be fined not less than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) nor more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or serve a prison sentence of not less than thirty (30) days nor more than six (6) months.
