## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Increasing the Salary of the Governor and Abolishing the Governor's Personal Contingent Fund.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Salary of governor increased. Section one of chapter one hundred twenty-five of the revised statutes is hereby amended by striking out the whole of said section and inserting in place thereof the following section:

'Sec. I. The governor. The governor shall receive an annual salary of twelve thousand dollars, but shall not receive any further allowances or emoluments except the use of the Blaine Mansion.'
