AN ACT to Exempt Certain Live Stock from Taxation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Exemption of certain live stock from taxation. Sub-section six of section six of chapter thirteen of the revised statutes is hereby amended by striking out in the third line of said sub-section the word "fifty" and inserting in place thereof the following words: 'three hundred, and all live stock less than two years old, and fifteen head over two years old, and three horses,' so that said sub-section as amended shall read as follows:

'VI. All mules and horses less than six months old, and neat cattle eighteen months old and under, and all sheep to the number of thirty-five, and swine to the number of ten and domestic fowl to the number of three hundred, and all live stock less than two years old, and fifteen head over two years old, and three horses.'
