IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Defining Location of Third Class Highway Construction.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Money apportioned to construction of third class highways must be expended on third class highways which are feeders to the state or state aid highway system. Said location must meet with the approval of the State Highway Commission.
