STATE OF MAINE

AN ACT to Authorize the City of South Portland to Pass Ordinances to Regulate Cemeteries and Burials.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

That the city council of the city of South Portland may provide by ordinance for the regulation of all existing and future cemeteries and burial grounds within its city limits and may by city ordinance, prohibit the burial of bodies within certain restricted and defined zones.
