IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT to Change the Name of Soward Island to Treasure Island.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Name of Soward Island changed to Treasure Island. The name of the island, heretofore known as Soward Island on chart number three hundred six, United States-East Coast-Maine, and as Sewards Island on Colby Atlas of Hancock county, eighteen hundred eighty-one, situated in Flanders Bay, adjacent to and near the east shore of Waukeag Neck, in the town of Sorrento, Hancock county, Maine, is hereby changed from Soward or Sewards Island to Treasure Island.
