STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT to Increase the Amount to be paid for Clerk Hire in the Office of Register of Deeds, in the County of Cumberland.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S. c. 125, sec. 46; relating to clerk hire in offices, amended. That the second line in paragraph four of section forty-six of chapter one hundred and twenty-five of the revised statutes be hereby amended by striking out the words "thirteen hundred" and inserting in place thereof the words 'fourteen hundred and four', so that said paragraph four, as amended, in so far as it relates to the annual amount to be paid to the Deputy Register of Deeds in Cumberland County, shall read as follows:

Cumberland County clerk hire increased. Deputy Register of deeds, fourteen hundred and four dollars.
