STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Increasing the Amount to be Paid for Clerk Hire in the Office of the Recorder of the Municipal Court of the City of Portland.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section forty-six of chapter one hundred and twenty-five of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by striking out in line five of paragraph four, after the words "Portland Municipal Court", the following words, "nineteen hundred seventy-six dollars" and inserting in place thereof the words 'twenty-four hundred ninety-six dollars', so that said paragraph so far as it refers to the amount to be paid for clerk hire in the office of the Recorder of the Portland Municipal Court, shall read as follows: 'for clerks in the office of recorder of the Portland Municipal Court, twenty-four hundred ninety-six dollars.'
