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STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

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RESOLVE, Providing for an Increase in State Pension for  
Lorenzo D. Wright of Fairfield.

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Resolved: That a pension of fifteen dollars per month be, and hereby is, granted to Lorenzo D. Wright, of Fairfield, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July first, nineteen hundred and thirty-one, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature, and shall be in lieu of the state pension which he is now receiving.

## STATEMENT OF FACTS

Lorenzo D. Wright is the son of the late Abel Wright who served in Co. H, 14th Maine Infantry, during the Civil War. He was granted a pension of eight dollars per month by Chapter 57 of the Resolves of 1921. At that time, he was living in the town of Montville. Said Lorenzo D. Wright is 80 years of age and in very poor circumstances.
