STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Florence H. Baker of Liberty.

Resolved: That a pension of fifteen dollars per month be, and hereby is, granted to Florence H. Baker, of Liberty, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July first, nineteen hundred and thirty-one, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.
