STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

RESOLVE, Providing for an Increase in State Pension for
Emily F. Grotton of Washington.

Resolved: That a pension of thirty dollars per month be,
and hereby is granted to Emily F. Grotton, of Washington,
to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers
and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin
July first, nineteen hundred and thirty-one, and continue until
otherwise provided by the legislature, and shall be in lieu of
the state pension which she is now receiving.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Emily F. Grotton is the widow of Alonzo L. Grotton, a Civil War veteran. She is 87 years of age and in very feeble health. She is entirely without means, other than the State pension which she is now receiving. She has no relatives who can help her.
