STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Flora E. Babb of West Gardiner.

Resolved: That a pension of twelve dollars per month be, and hereby is, granted to Flora E. Babb, of West Gardiner, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July first, nineteen hundred and thirty-one, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Flora E. Babb is the daughter of Edwin Babb, who served in Co. B, 3rd Maine Infantry, and Co. A, 17th Maine Infantry, during the Civil War. She is 63 years of age and a widow. Her physical condition is very bad, and she is without means of support.
