STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Bertha Gordon
of Union.

Resolved: That a pension of twelve dollars per month be,
and hereby is, granted to Bertha Gordon, of Union, to be paid
quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors
and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July first,
nineteen hundred and thirty-one, and continue until otherwise
provided by the legislature.
