## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT to Authorize York Harbor Village to Appropriate Money to Improve a Certain Part of York River; Also to Appoint an Inspector of Buildings.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

York Harbor Village Corporation is hereby authorized, by vote of its inhabitants, to raise money in any manner provided by its charter, for the purpose of dredging or otherwise improving York River between the mouth of said river and the westerly side of the railroad bridge extending across said river. Such work may be done in tide waters on either or both sides of the channel of said river, and may, when found expedient, be carried out in conjunction with or under the Federal Government.
