STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the State School for Girls.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of two thousand dollars for the fiscal year ending June thirty, nineteen hundred thirty-two, in favor of the state school for girls, to repair the roof of Baker Cottage, so-called, at said school.
