STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to a State Aid road in the town of Sangerville.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Whereas the town of Sangerville at a special town meeting in 1930 voted to anticipate State aid funds in completing the road between Sangerville Village and North Dexter and are combining with the towns of Guilford and Dover-Foxcroft in raising State Aid funds for 1931 under the so-called Three Town Act, said town of Sangerville may be reimbursed from the 1931 State Aid fund for the completion of the so-called North Dexter road in 1930.
