RESOLVE, in Favor of State School for Boys.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of three thousand dollars for the fiscal year ending June thirty, nineteen hundred thirty-two, and two thousand dollars for the fiscal year ending June thirty, nineteen hundred thirty-three, in favor of the State School for Boys, to enable the trustees of said school to carry out the provisions of section ten of chapter one hundred fifty-four of the revised statutes.
